Important Rate Information for Commercial and Industrial Customers

This bill insert contains important information about your 2010 electric bill, including fuel charges and electric base rates.

Each January, Tampa Electric puts into effect the fuel charges that were approved by the Florida Public Service Commission (FPSC) in the company's annual fuel filing. Fuel costs are passed through from fuel suppliers to our customers with no markup or profit to Tampa Electric. The reduced fuel charges are due to lower natural gas cost projections for 2010 and the company's ongoing cost management efforts.

Also effective with your January 2010 bill is a base rate increase recently approved by the FPSC and originally associated with the rate increase authorized by the FPSC in April 2009. This increase reflects cost recovery for five new peak generating units and new rail facilities installed this year. The increase has been granted subject to refund, pending further review and a hearing at the FPSC.

We have several rate schedules for our commercial and industrial customers. Depending on the actual maximum electricity load your facility requires, we will select the appropriate rate schedule. (Your rate schedule appears in the center portion of your bill under "New Charges").

General Service Demand Rate Schedules

The charges assume meter and service at secondary voltage. The energy charge includes 1.083 cents per kilowatt-hour (kWh) for rate schedule GSD-option for the conservation, environmental and capacity cost recovery charges. The energy charge includes 0.485 cents per kWh for rate schedules GSD and GSDT for the environmental cost recovery charge. The billing demand charges for rate schedules GSD and GSDT, respectively, include \$2.62 per kW for the conservation and capacity cost recovery charges.

The fuel charge is used to pay the fuel suppliers and does not profit Tampa Electric.

Interruptible Service Rate Schedules

The charges assume meter and service at primary voltage. The energy charge includes 0.474 cents per kilowatt-hour (kWh) for environmental recovery charges. The billing demand charges include \$2.33 per kW for the conservation and capacity cost recovery charges.

The fuel charge is used to pay the fuel suppliers and does not profit Tampa Electric.

Rate schedules are subject to gross receipts taxes, city and state taxes, and franchise fees, where applicable. A late payment charge may be applied to any unpaid balance on your electric bill that is not paid by the past due date.
