On June 19, 2019, Tampa Electric Company (Tampa Electric), filed a notice of cancellation of its Wholesale Requirements Tariff (WR Tariff), which is currently on file as Tampa Electric's FERC Electric Tariff, Second Revised Volume No. 1. Tampa Electric states that all three of the service agreements under the WR Tariff have been terminated and there has been no service under the WR Tariff since the end of 2012. Tampa Electric states that as a result it seeks to cancel the WR Tariff.

Pursuant to the authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation – East, under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307, your submittal is accepted for filing effective June 20, 2019, as requested.

The filing was noticed on June 19, 2019, with comments, interventions, and protests due on or before July 10, 2019. Pursuant to Rule 214 (18 C.F.R. § 385.214 (2018)), to the extent that any timely filed motions to intervene and any motion to intervene out-of-time were filed before the issuance date of this order, such interventions are granted. Granting late interventions at this stage of the proceeding will not disrupt the proceeding or place additional burdens on existing parties.

This acceptance for filing shall not be construed as constituting approval of the referenced filing or of any rate, charge, classification, or any rule, regulation, or practice affecting such rate or service contained in your filing; nor shall such acceptance be

deemed as recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation associated therewith; and such acceptance is without prejudice to any findings or orders which have been or may hereafter be made by the Commission in any proceeding now pending or hereafter instituted by or against Tampa Electric.

This order constitutes final agency action. Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date of issuance of this order, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713.
