The grating fastener (clamp) Stk. No. 6226928 is, in general, the correct grating fastener to be used. The fastener (trade name "G-Clip" manufactured by Grating Fasteners, Inc. (GFI)) comes as a complete unit, i.e., a top plate with ears, bolt and beam clamp with teeth. There is **no separate screw required** to install the unit. The installation of this fastener (clamp) does not require drilling into the supporting steel.

The optional grating fastener (sometimes called a saddle clip) Stk. No. 6201535 <u>does require</u> a separate screw (self-tapping screw Stk. No. 6201534) to be installed. This fastener is only to be used in a place where the 6226928 fastener cannot be installed correctly. The use of this fastener requires drilling the self-tapping screw into the support steel to fasten the saddle clip to the support steel.
