

We're lowering your bills. Again.

We understand these are challenging times, and that's why we're pleased to share that customers will see significantly reduced bills this summer, plus lower prices for the rest of the year. Bills in June through August will be reduced more than 20 percent, and residential customers will save an estimated \$90 on energy costs for the second half of 2020.

Here's why you'll pay less beginning in June 2020:



Fuel. Due to lower natural gas prices, Tampa Electric requested a significant decrease to customer bills. Because of the unusual circumstances of the coronavirus pandemic, the utility sought to accelerate the savings for customers, beginning in June. For the months of June, July, and August, customers will receive a temporary fuel credit on their bills. In addition, the fuel charge for the months of June through December will be reduced.



Capacity. Customers will receive a credit on their bills for capacity charges, the cost of buying power (or 'capacity') from the energy market, during the months of June through December.

Tampa Electric's rates are among the lowest in the state and will be more than 20% lower than the national average.

The rate schedules above are subject to gross receipts taxes, city and state taxes, and franchise fees, where applicable. A late payment charge may be applied to any unpaid balance on your electric bill that is not paid by the past-due date.

The energy charge includes 0.464 cents per kWh for rate schedule RS, (0.493) cents per kWh for rate schedule RSVP-1 (based on P2 pricing - rate can vary based on rate tier), 0.449 cents per kWh for rate schedules GS and GST for the conservation, environmental and capacity cost recovery charges.
